he SOLD OUT Living Legends Gala, a fundraising event to support the Museum of African American History, was held Sunday, December 8, 2019 at the Four Seasons Hotel in Boston. "Black-ish" star, Anthony Anderson, returned as host and Four-time Grammy Winner, Esperanza Spalding, and Oscar Winner for costume design, Ruth E. Carter, both received the coveted historic silver cup to honor women making history. Co-Chairs Mark C. Touhey of Liberty Mutual and Paul Francisco of State Street Corporation led the efforts that contributed to the Gala raising a record breaking close to \$500k for the Museum. Anderson had the audience laughing in hysterics during the program as he roamed the room to take selfies with attendees shaking their African instruments.
